The Working Group (WG) Construction History, chaired by Eberhard Pelke, Germany, held its 2nd meeting in Hamburg on Nov. 22-23, 2013. The mission of this new WG is based on three main objectives: 1) increase awareness among structural engineers for historical and cultural aspects of structures and structural engineering; 2) illustrate and propagate the social and technical achievements of civil engineering; 3) improve methods and practice in structural engineering by showing ways for systematic and targeted integration of historical and cultural aspects in intervention projects to adapt or modify structures of high cultural values for future demands. There will be an article on this WG in the coming issue of SEI (SEI 1/14 Feb).
