This 'Structural Engineering Document (SED)', by Ian Smith, Canada and Andrea Frangi, Switzerland, provides guidance to engineers on how to properly design multi-storey buildings that incorporate timber and timber-based products as superstructure elements. The scope encompasses traditional systems for buildings up to 10 storeys made from conventional timber products and innovative systems that employ modern timber-based composites, as well as emerging possibilities for using timber elements in very tall buildings.
