Safety, Robustness and Condition Assessment of Structures

This IABSE Workshop will be held in Helsinki from February 11-12, 2015, and focuses on structures that can cause notable safety concerns. The Workshop also addresses the topical question of creating assessment codes for existing structures and the role of condition-assessment data in them. The purpose of the Workshop is to provide a meeting point and discussion forum to any professional interested in the theme. It is the continuation of the IABSE Workshop 'Safety, Failures and Robustness of Large Structures' Helsinki 2013. Topics: Assessment codes and guidelines for existing structures; validation of probabilistic design methods; quality of non-destructive testing and

structural monitoring; risk handling for hazards and extreme events; fire; progressive collapse, redundancy and alternate load paths; forensic engineering of structures; and human-made hazards. <u>More information.</u>
