2. IABSE Geneva Conference 2015 - Technical Visits

In addition to the exciting Technical Programme for the Geneva Conference, some excellent visits are being organised. A walking tour will take place on Friday September 25, 2015, after the end of the Conference and includes: 1) Existing structures as a source of inspiration for break-through structural engineering': Clarté House by Le Corbusier, Sicli Shell by Heinz Isler, Vessy Bridge by Robert Maillart. 2) 'Structural engineering of buildings in the line of contemporary architecture' incl. Japan Tobacco Building, and 3) Structural engineering for urbanisation: CEVA railway

stations meeting modern mobility demands.

On Friday September 25, 2015, there will be a two-day Technical Tour 'Mythic Bridges in the German Part of Switzerland' visiting the bridges Salginatobel; Sunniberg; Tamina; Traversina and Punt da Surensus.

On Saturday September 26, 2015, a full day Technical Tour 'Art-structures in the Lake Geneva Region' will include the EPFL Learning Centre, SwissTec Convention Centre, Pavilions Kuma and a visit to the EPFL Civil Engineering Structural testing halls. Also on the programme are the Chillon Viaducts; the Poya cable-stayed bridge in Fribourg, and the 'House of Writing' in Montricher.

5. Results of Young Engineers Workshop Nara Published!

On May 12, 2015, in the afternoon before the Nara Conference, the workshop, 'Elegance in Structures: the Footbridge' was held for Young Engineers, 35 years or younger. The workshop was a design competition for a footbridge which span was 26m assumed to cross the Saho River in Nara City, and consisted of lectures by prominent engineers, presentations by young engineers, question and answer sessions, and an awarding ceremony. All participating teams/individuals submitted their designs in advance and made presentations at the workshop. The total number of all the contributing young engineers who prepared for making designs were 65 from 9 countries, and more than 50 young engineers participated in the workshop. All the participating teams proposed interesting and ingenious designs with elegant visual images. Finally, an Outstanding Design Award, an Excellent Design Award, and three Exceptional Design Awards were given to five teams. The results of the Workshop have been published online here..

Luc Taerwe, Belgium – has been awarded with Life Membership at its Symposium in Copenhagen in May 2015. Dr Taerwe is recognised for his commitment to the *fib* and its predecessor organisations in such roles as Chair of the CEB Task Group I/2 Model Uncertainties and Interaction Problems (1991-1995), Co-chair of the Second International Symposium on Quality Control of Concrete Structures (1991) and as a member of the CEB Advisory Committee, CEB Strategy Group and CEB Administrative Council. Since the creation of the *fib* Dr Taerwe has been the head of the Belgian national delegation (1998-present), Chair of the *fib*'s former Commission 2: Safety and Performance Concepts (1998-2014) and a member of the former SAG5: New Model Code (2002-2011). Since 2006 he has served as Editor-in-Chief of the *fib*'s Structural Concrete journal, leading it to its current Impact Factor of 0.857.
