4. SED 13 published: Use of Timber in Tall Multi-Storey Buildings

Much has been written in the last few decades about the relative merits of alternative materials for building construction. As part of such efforts, this Structural Engineering Document (SED) provides guidance to engineers on how to properly design multi-storey buildings that incorporate timber and timber-based products as superstructure elements. The scope encompasses traditional systems for buildings up to 10 storeys made from conventional timber products and innovative systems that employ modern timber-based composites, as well as

emerging possibilities for using timber elements in very tall buildings.

The intended audience for this SED is structural engineering practitioners, construction professionals, academic researchers, code drafting bodies, and students. However it is hoped that there will be ancillary audiences amongst architects, property developers, town planners, and governmental policy makers.

Brasil - About 300 engineers attended the VII Brazilian Conference on Bridges and Structures (VII CBPE) in Rio de Janeiro from May 21-23, 2014, which was organised by ABECE (Brazilian Association of Consulting Engineers) and ABPE (Brazilian Association of Bridges and Structures, representing the Brazilian Group of IABSE). The main theme of the Conference was the 40th anniversary of the inauguration of Rio-Niterói Bridge. Aspects of the design, construction, monitoring and repairing of the bridge, were remembered with special presentations by Engineers B. Ernani Diaz and Carlos Henrique Siqueira. [Read more..](#)

China - The Chinese Group of IABSE held a representative meeting of IABSE Chinese Members in Dalian, Liaoning Province on May 26, 2014. On behalf of 132 individual members and 11 collective members of IABSE, 25 representatives attended the meeting.
